
ACCESSIBILITY AT LA MAISON DE LA CHIMIE

As part of our **commitment to inclusion**, our premises are designed to enable everyone, including those with reduced mobility or living with a disability, to independently access and move around throughout those of our areas that are open to the public.

La Maison de la Chimie **inclusion pays particular attention to people with sensorial, cognitive or temporary disabilities**, and endeavours to offer solutions appropriate to their specific needs.

1- Access and parking:

There is a drop-off area in front of the premises.

The two main entrances (at nos. 28 and 28 bis) are fitted with platform lifts, providing access to the historical reception rooms.

2 - Moving around inside:

The building has standards-compliant lifts, enabling those with reduced mobility to access all levels open to the public easily and independently.

The reception desks incorporate a lower section.

3 - Auditoriums:

Places reserved for wheelchair users are provided and evenly distributed to ensure they are fully included within the audience as a whole.

4 - Sanitary facilities:

Suitable, accessible sanitary facilities are available on every level that is open to the public.

5 - Safety and assistance:

To ensure you have the best possible experience in complete safety, our trained staff, including our fire safety officers (SSIAP accredited), are on hand to assist you as you move around the premises, if you so wish.

Our alarm systems emit both audible and visual signals appropriate to different types of disability. In addition, secure waiting areas (refuge areas) are provided on each floor for people with reduced mobility.

In this way, we ensure that every visitor enjoys a comfortable, safe experience that can meet all potential needs.
